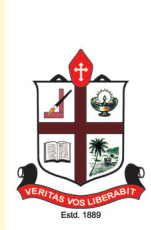

INSTITUTION

St Thomas' College is a government-aided college located in Thrissur City, the Cultural Capital of Kerala, India. Founded by Mar Adolphus Edwin Medlycott in 1889 as an educational institution, it was raised to the status of a Second Grade College, affiliated to University of Madras, in 1919. In 2018-19, the centenary celebrations of this landmark was inaugurated by the President of the Republic of India. The college is the earliest First Grade College in the erstwhile princely state of Cochin. It is also the first Catholic college in Kerala and is managed by the Syro-Malabar Catholic Archdiocese of Thrissur. Mar Andrews Thazhath is the Patron and Mar Tony Neelankavil is the Manager of the College now. The college is graced by visits of Mahatma Gandhi, Presidents, scientists, scholars and saints. The institution is the alma mater to three former chief ministers of the state and many other ministers, sportsmen, businessmen, scientists and many others who have contributed immensely to the nation.

The college is affiliated to the University of Calicut. It was conferred Autonomous status in 2014 and was recognised as College with Potential for Excellence by University Grants Commission (UGC) in 2016. The College was awarded A Grade in its third cycle of accreditation by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) after the peer team review in 2016. The College is financially supported by the UGC, Department of Science and Technology (FIST scheme) and Department of BioTechnology (Star college scheme) of Government of India. St Thomas is also a mentor college for NAAC accreditation aspirant institutions under Paramarsh scheme. College ranks 63rd at the national level in National Institute Ranking Framework (NIRF) 2020 of Government of India.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION AND INDEXING FOR RANKING

- Those candidates who are "Eligible for Higher Studies" as per the Higher Secondary Examination, Kerala or a pass in the equivalent examinations can apply for admission to degree courses, unless otherwise specified. (U.O.No 2393/2015/Admn Dated: 10.03.2015).
- The candidates who have qualified the HSE and VHSE of the Government of Kerala under 'SAY' scheme and Compartmental Examination of CBSE are also eligible for admission to first year degree courses in the same academic year. (U.O. No. GAI/A2/ 5753/2000 dated 14.05.2004).
- The candidates possessing certificate with "Eligible for Higher Studies" issued by the Kerala State Literacy Mission Authority are also eligible for Humanities and Commerce programmes. (U.O No. 408/2019/Admn Dated: 11.01.2019).
- Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of Tamil Nadu (Private study) shall not be eligible to apply to any courses. (U.O.No.GAI/A1/5062/2002 dated 07.07.2005).
- The visually challenged candidates are not eligible for admission to Science subjects (involving practical) except BCA and BSc Computer Science.
- All candidates qualified the Higher Secondary Examination or its equivalent examinations held up to and including the annual examinations of the proceeding academic years are eligible for admission.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- The admission of the students who obtained the same index marks shall be decided first on the basis of age and then by name in alphabetical order unless otherwise specified. (U.O. No. GA1/A2/7226/ 2000 dated : 04-05-2001).
- In the case of VHSE candidates for admissions to BCom/BBA programmes and all other programmes that come under Commerce and Management faculty, the index marks shall be arrived at by taking the marks of all the subjects except that of the marks of Vocational practicals and Internship Evaluation. (U.O. No. 2422/2015 dated : 11.03.2015).
- In the case of VHSE candidates for admissions to BA programmes, index marks shall be arrived at by taking the marks of all the papers except that of

Vocational practicals and Internship Evaluation/Skill Evaluation Module. (U.O. No. 2422/2015 dated : 11.03.2015).

- In the case of courses equivalent to Plus two of Kerala HSE and have maximum marks or grades not in line with that of Plus two of Kerala HSE, the same will be normalized to the maximum marks of Plus two of Kerala HSE and the rank list will be prepared accordingly. (U.O. No. 2422/2015 dated : 11.03.2015).
- For admissions to BA programmes, the existing weightage of 25 marks shall be increased to 50, for those who have studied the subject concerned (mentioned in the present admission rule) in HSE or equivalent. (U.O. No. 2422/2015 dated : 11.03.2015)
- A concession of 5% will be given to OBC/OEC candidates. The SC/ST candidates need get only a pass.

ELIGIBILITY FOR UG ADMISSION

B.Sc MATHEMATICS

Eligibility Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent there to with Mathematics group only are eligible for admission to Bsc Mathematics.

Index Mark Total marks obtained for Part III + the marks obtained for the Mathematics for BSc Mathematics.

B.Sc STATISTICS

Eligibility Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent there to with Mathematics group or candidates who have studied Mathematics/Statistics/Computer Application with other combination at HSE level are also eligible for admission to Bsc Statistics. (U.O. No.GA I/JI/4756/1999 dated 11.01.2002)

Index Mark Total marks obtained for Part III + the marks obtained for the Statistics/Mathematics/Computer Application.

B.Sc PHYSICS

Eligibility Candidates who have passed (eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent there to with science subjects are eligible for admission.

Index Mark Total marks obtained for Part III + the marks obtained for the optional subject concerned.

B.Sc CHEMISTRY

Eligibility Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent there to with science subjects are eligible for admission.

Index Mark Total marks obtained for Part III + the marks obtained for Chemistry.



B.Sc BOTANY

Eligibility Candidates who have passed (Eligible for higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent there to with Biology as a compulsory paper are eligible for admission

Index Mark Total marks obtained for Part III + the marks obtained for Biology or Botany.

B.Sc ZOOLOGY

Eligibility Candidates who have passed (Eligible for higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent there to with Biology as a compulsory paper are eligible for admission

Index Mark Total marks obtained for Part III + the marks obtained for Biology, or Zoology.

B.Sc COMPUTER SCIENCE

Eligibility Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with Mathematics/ Computer Science/ Computer Application/ Information Technology/ Informatics Practice/ Informatics/ Additional Mathematics are eligible for admission. (U.O.No.GAI/JI/4756/1999 dated 11.01.2002)

Index Mark Total Part III + marks secured for Mathematics in the case of Science group with Mathematics as one of the

subject AND Total Part III + marks secured for Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/ Informatics Practice/ Informatics/ Additional Mathematics in the case of other combinations without Mathematics as one of the subject. If the Candidates has studied both Mathematics and any one of the following subjects Computer Science/ Computer Application/ Information Technology/ Informatics Practice/ Informatics/ Additional Mathematics then the marks secured for Mathematics or Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/ Informatics Practice/ Informatics/ Additional Mathematics which ever is higher will added.

BACHELOR OF COMPUTER APPLICATION

Eligibility Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent there to with Mathematics/ Computer Science/ Computer Application/ Information Technology/ Informatics Practice/ Informatics/ Additional Mathematics as one of the subjects are eligible for admissions (U.O. No.GAI/J1/2453/1997 dated 06.10.2000 and GA I/J1/1597/2005 dated 11.07.2005).

Index Mark Total Part III + marks secured for Mathematics in the case of Science group with Mathematics as one of the subject AND Total Part III + marks secured for Computer Science/Computer Application/ Information Technology/ Informatics Practice/ Informatics in

the case of other combinations without Mathematics as one of the subject. If the Candidates has studied both Mathematics and any one of the following subjects Computer Science/ Computer Application/ Information Technology/Informatics Practice/ Informatics then the marks secured for Mathematics or Computer Science/ Computer Application/ Information Technology which ever is higher will added

B.Sc ELECTRONICS

Eligibility Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent thereto with Electronics/Physics/Mathematics as one of the optional subjects are eligible for admission. (U.O. No.GA I/ J1/2924/2005(2) dated 28.07.2005)

Index Mark Total marks obtained for Part III + marks of Electronics/Physics/Mathematics as the case may be. If than one of the subjects had been offered at the +2 level, the subject with the highest marks will be added. An additional weightage of 25 marks will be added for those who have studied Electronics. An additional weightage of 10 marks for candidates passed VHSE with papers like Electronic Service Technology, Maintenance Operation of Bio Medical equipments, Maintenance and Repairs of Domestic Appliances and Maintenance and Repairs of Television

B.Com FINANCE

Eligibility Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the

Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent thereto with at least one commerce subject are eligible for admissions to the B.Com degree course. Candidates who have not studied commerce subject for Higher Secondary or an equivalent examination not less than 45% marks are also eligible. A concession of 5% will be given to OBC/OEC candidates. The SC/ST candidates need get only a pass. (U.O. No.GAI/A2/1658/2007 dated 28.02.2008).

Index Mark Total marks + 25 marks for each commerce papers subject to maximum of 50 marks. Candidates who have not studied commerce subject for Higher Secondary or an equivalent examination not less than 45% marks are also eligible. A concession of 5% will be given to OBC/OEC candidates. The SC/ST candidates need get only a pass. (U.O. No.GAI/A2/1658/2007 dated 28.02.2008).

Index Mark Total marks + 25 marks for each commerce papers subject to maximum of 50 marks. Index Mark Total Plus Two marks + twice the marks secured Part I English (i.e. Additional second languages) + 50 marks for History/Islamic Jurisprudence (Faah and Aquaid)/Islamic History/History of Islam and history Arabic Literature + 20 marks for Part III Optional English Literature/Communicative English in HSE or equivalent.

BA ECONOMICS

Eligibility Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto are eligible for admission.

Index Mark Total Plus Two marks + a weightage of 50 marks for those who have studied Economics as optional subjects in HSE or equivalent.

BA MULTIMEDIA

Eligibility Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent thereto with not less than 45% marks in aggregate shall be eligible for admission. A concession of (5%) will be given to OBC/OEC candidates. The SC/ST candidates need get only a pass (Eligible for Higher Studies)

Index Mark Total Plus Two marks + 50 marks for the papers Multimedia/ Multimedia and Web Technology concerned optional only. An additional 50 marks will be awarded for VHS passout students if they have studied the Vocational course – Graphic Design and Printing Technology.

BA VISUAL COMMUNICATION

Eligibility Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognised as equivalent thereto with not less than 45% marks in aggregate shall be eligible for admission. A concession of (5%) will be given to OBC/OEC candidates. The SC/ST candidates need get only a pass (Eligible for Higher Studies)

Index Mark Total Plus Two marks + 50 marks for the papers Multimedia/ Multimedia and Web Technology concerned optional only. An additional 50 marks will be awarded for VHS passout students if they have studied the Vocational course – Graphic Design and Printing Technology.

BA CRIMINOLOGY AND POLICE SCIENCE

Eligibility Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto are eligible for admission.



Index Mark Total Plus Two marks + a weightage of 50 marks for those who have studied Psychology as option subjects in HSE or equivalent

B VOC DATA SCIENCE

Eligibility Candidates who have passed (Eligible for Higher Studies) the HSE of the Kerala State Board of Higher Secondary Examination or any other examination recognized as equivalent thereto with Mathematics/ Computer Science/ Computer Application/ Information Technology/ Informatics Practice/ Informatics/ Additional Mathematics are eligible for admission.

Index Mark Total Part III + marks secured for Mathematics in the case of Science group with Mathematics as one of the subject AND Total Part III + marks secured for Computer Science/ Computer Application/ Information Technology/ Informatics Practice/ Informatics/ Additional Mathematics in the case of other combinations without Mathematics as one of the sub-

ject. For candidates under grading system overall CGPA at least equivalent to 50%.

M.A. ECONOMICS

Eligibility BA degree from University of Calicut with Economics/Foreign Trade/ Development Economics (Main/core) or equivalent degree with at least 55% marks for Part III (excluding subsidiaries) or equivalent grade OR BSc Degree of this University with Statistics/Mathematics/Computer Science (Main/core) with 70% marks for Part III (excluding subsidiaries) or equivalent grade

M.A. VISUAL COMMUNICATION*

Eligibility Any student who has passed any degree of the University of Calicut or that of any other university or Institute recognised by the UGC or AICTE and ratified by the University of Calicut as equivalent there to with not less than an aggregate minimum of 45% marks or with an equivalent grade point under the regular stream (or in the distance stream) is eligible for admission.

Eligibility Bachelor's Degree in any discipline recognised by the University of Calicut with a minimum of 50% aggregate marks/grade. For those disciplines, which do not have English, only main and subsidiary marks/grade will be taken into consideration.

Eligibility Any candidate who has passed B.Com or BBA (earlier BBS) degree of University of Calicut or B.COM, BBA or BBM or BBS degree of any other University or Institute in any State recognised by UGC or AICTE with a minimum of 45% marks or equivalent grade

M.Sc. BOTANY

Eligibility Bachelor degree in Botany or Plant Science of University of Calicut or equivalent qualification with a minimum of 50% marks in the main (core) subject under the mark system or equivalent grade under the grade

system, with 45% marks or equivalent grade in the case of OBC/OEC candidates and with a pass in the case of SC/ST candidates

M.Sc. CHEMISTRY

Eligibility B.Sc. Degree of Calicut University with Chemistry/ Industrial Chemistry/ Polymer Chemistry (Main/core) or equivalent degree with Physics & Mathematics subsidiaries with at least 50% marks or equivalent grade for Part III (excluding subsidiaries).

M.Sc. COMPUTER SCIENCE

Eligibility The candidate should have secured at least 55% of marks or equivalent grade in BSc. Computer Science or Information Technology or Electronics or Physics or Mathematics or Statistics or Chemistry) or BCA or B.Tech/BE (Computer Science or Information Technology or Electronics or Electronics and Telecommunication or Electronics and Communication) of Calicut University or equivalent degree.

M.Sc. ELECTRONICS*

Eligibility BSc Degree of Calicut University with Electronics/ Physics /Computer Science / Instrumentation (Main) or equivalent degree with at least 50% marks for Part III. OBC/OEC candidates are eligible to relaxation up to 5%. SC/ST candidates need only to get a pass



M.Sc. MATHEMATICS

Eligibility B.Sc. Degree in Mathematics (Main) or equivalent degree with at least 50% marks or equivalent grade in core and at least 50% marks or equivalent grade in Part III (core and complementary put together)

M.Sc. PHYSICS

Eligibility B.Sc Degree in Physics/Applied Physics (Core) of Calicut university or an equivalent degree, with Mathematics as compulsory complementary, having 50% mark or equivalent grade in Part III (Core and complementary put together). In the case of applicants with tripple main/ three majors, they should have Physics and Mathematics as two mains/majors

and should have minimum 50% marks or equivalent grade, while putting the three mains/majors together

M.Sc. STATISTICS

Eligibility At least 50% marks or equivalent grade in Statistics/ Applied Statistics (Main) /Mathematics & Statistics (Double Main/core)/ Mathematics (Main/core) with Statistics as one of the subsidiaries in the B.Sc. Degree of Calicut University or equivalent degree

M.Sc. ZOOLOGY

Eligibility B.Sc Degree of Calicut University, or equivalent/recognised degree with Zoology (main/core) with 50% marks or equivalent grade in core (Part III excluding subsidiaries)

SOCIAL SERVICE

For post graduate programmes, if the applicant has successfully completed Compulsory Social Service scheme of the Calicut University, tick in the box and produce the original certificate at the time of interview. teaching and learning environment of the institution.

FEE CONCESSIONS AND STIPENDS

Students of scheduled castes / tribes (SC/ST) or other backward communities (OBC) are eligible for fee concession under various schemes of the Government. Those eligible for fee concession must produce the community/income certificate of the parents from the Village Officer at the time of admission. In case of discontinuation of programme, student should refund the scholarship or concession amount received, before obtaining the certificates.

BONUS MARKS
